Checking in again for an update on the North Shore Maui Greenway. I'm sure know already, a minivan crashed into the trail construction retaining wall and has been there for a week or so.

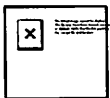

We just published an Ask the Mayor response to an inquiry on the North Shore Greenway Project. Here's the question and response:

Q: *Is there any update on the Pā'ia bikeway project near Baldwin Beach Park? It looks like work has stopped. Thank you for your time and consideration.*

A: Mahalo for your question. Our Department of Public Works reported that the North Shore Greenway, Phase IV project between Ulupua Place and Baldwin Park has been delayed due to an unexpected waterline issue beneath the new bridge structure.

The Department is currently coordinating revisions to the bridge abutments with the Department of Water Supply to best accommodate the existing waterline without causing disruption to existing water service to the Pā'ia area.
