Molina requests FAA Administrator to adjust flight patterns over North Shore of Maui

WAILUKU – Councilmember Michael J. Molina transmitted correspondence to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Administrator Steve Dickson requesting adjustments to flight patterns over the North Shore/Haiku region of Maui, Hawaii.

In the correspondence Molina noted that since late 2019, he has received numerous complaints about the noise and disturbance from air traffic in the Haiku region.

Molina also noted that he has communicated with various FAA personnel to secure assistance for adjusting the flight patterns but to date he has received no response or assistance from FAA.

“I have been trying to work with FAA personnel for nearly a year without any response, said Molina. Therefore, I found it necessary to take our concerns directly to the Administrator.”

“I am disappointed with the lack of response from the FAA, said Molina. The jets are causing a serious amount of noise for the residents of this region therefore this matter requires immediate attention to allow the residents of the North Shore the quiet enjoyment of their property.”

Molina transmitted the letter to our Congressional delegation, Congressman-Elect Kai Kahele and United States Senators Mazie Hirono and Brian Schatz requesting their intervention on the matter.
