**Update: Temporary waiver of Central Maui Landfill tipping fees
extended to April 2, 2021**
Waiver is for Haiku residents impacted by flooding

Mayor Michael Victorino has extended to April 2, 2021, a temporary waiver for non-billed landfill drop off for Haiku residents with accumulated **mixed debris** from recent flooding in Haiku.

"We extended the fee waiver to give our residents more time to clean up after recent flooding," Mayor Victorino said. "Waiving fees at the Central Maui Landfill helps those affected by recent floods save some money, and it discourages illegal dumping throughout the island."

Landfill waivers now will be allowed at the Central Maui Landfill until Saturday, April 2. Please note the landfill will close at noon on Prince Kuhio Day, Friday, March 26, and on Good Friday, April 2.

Those seeking a landfill tipping fee waiver must fill out Page 1 of County's waiver request form. This is for affected Haiku residents only or a contracted hauler.

Waiver forms can be obtained on the department's Solid Waste Division website. While on the page, search in the upper right hand corner for "Maui County Landfill Tipping Waiver." Or, use the following address:

The request form must contain the physical Haiku address of the residence of where the debris is coming from. If a commercial hauler is used for several residences, all individual residents' names and addresses must be attached for verification.

When arriving at the landfill, drive directly to scale with filled out form. DO NOT drive thru residential drop off lane.

Note: All existing landfill prohibited items remain in effect: no batteries, tires, fuel tanks, white goods, and hazardous materials, among other items. Refer to the Solid Waste Website for details.

If a resident is hauling non-contaminated green waste only, a waiver is not required. Follow signs to EKO as normal.

All construction and demolition (C&D) hauled materials must follow normal C&D procedures. Refer to website instruction at:
